# OUR CLASSES

## **RAD CLASSICAL BALLET**

A beautiful and disciplined dance style focusing on technique, grace, posture, strength, and coordination. Ballet builds strong foundations for all styles. Exam opportunities are available but not required to progress with peers.

## **ADA JAZZ**

A high-energy style inspired by musical theatre, commercials, and music videos. Jazz combines ballet technique with strength, flexibility, and isolations. Exam opportunities are available but not compulsory.

## **ADA TAP**

A fun and rhythmic style using percussive footwork to create sound and musical patterns. Dancers explore rhythm, timing, and coordination in an energetic class. Exam opportunities are available but optional.

## **CONTEMPORARY**

An expressive and creative style blending ballet technique, floor work, agility, and fluid movement. Dancers learn to connect movement with emotion, music, and storytelling.

## **HIP HOP**

A fun, energetic style drawing from urban dance techniques such as popping, locking, breaking, and isolations. Perfect for dancers who love upbeat movement and performance without the fuss.

## **ACROBATICS**

A structured program combining dance and acrobatic skills, focusing on flexibility, strength, balance, and tumbling. Safe progressions guide dancers from beginner skills to advanced stage-ready acro.

## **TECH (FLEX)**

A conditioning class focused on strength, flexibility, and core stability. Highly recommended for all dancers to support improved kicks, turns, leaps, and injury prevention.

## **KICKS / TURNS / LEAPS**

TKL classes give dancers the tools they need to grow across all styles, developing strong turns, powerful kicks, and confident jumps while improving strength, flexibility, and technique.

# ENROLMENT PROCESS

We are excited to offer online enrolments via Dance Studio Pro, a user-friendly platform where you will also agree to our Terms and Conditions of Enrolment. Please ensure you read this policy carefully before accepting, as it outlines how our studio operates.

Once registered, you can browse our class offerings and book a free trial. We'll send a confirmation email once your trial request is received.

After your child completes their trial, we'll contact you to finalise enrolment if you wish to continue. No payment or commitment is required until we hear from you.

If you're unsure which class to select, please contact our office team at [enquiries@rhythmedge.com](mailto:enquiries@rhythmedge.com). We offer free trials for all classes to help your child find the right fit. During Term 1 only, we can assist with class changes (subject to availability).

Enrolments are per term and automatically continue throughout the year unless we are notified before the end of the current term. All students must re-enrol each year via a simple online form.

New students may trial at any point during the term and will only be charged for remaining lessons. Once enrolled, a place is secured for the year. Fees are non-refundable for missed classes, and catch-up lessons are not available for senior students. For extenuating circumstances, please contact reception.

Our Dance Studio Pro portal also allows you to conveniently manage your account in one place. You can view your account balance, make payments, use our studio chat feature, order uniforms, access practice videos during concert term, and stay up to date with important studio information.

- Tan Slicks Tap Shoes
- Black Leotard
- Tan Convertible Stockings
- Tan Slicks Tap Shoes

### GRADE 5 - BAR TO GOLD

- Black Leotard
- Tan Convertible Stockings
- May wear shorts over leotard
- Black 'Slicks' Tap Shoes

- Hair must be completely off face in a ballet bun with no fringes.

### GRADES 2 -5

- Choice of REDS Leotard

### BRONZE - BAR TO GOLD

- Hair must be completely off face in a bun or ponytail with no fringes.

## HIP HOP

Dancers can choose anything from our merch wall and style it up with their favourite streetwear pieces — anything goes as long as it's red and/or black. Our new studio tees are a fave and works perfectly for Hip Hop and Contemporary vibes.

Sneakers are the go-to for this class, but please no school shoes. To keep our studio clean (and sand-free!), we ask that dancers arrive in clean sneakers only.



## ACRO

- REDS Merch
- No shoes required.
- Hair must be completely off face in a ballet bun with absolutely no fringes or 'whispy' bits. Please take extra care when doing your child's hair for acro, it will need extra hairspray to stay in until the extra lesson.

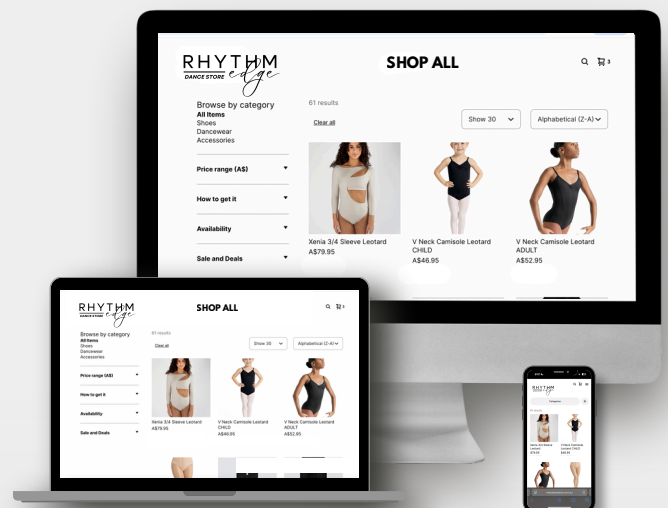
## CONTEMPORARY - TECH - KICKS/ TURNS / LEAPS

All Uniforms are available for purchase from reception. If we do not have the required sizes in stock, an order form will be available instead.

## TERM DATES

### **Term 1 – Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> February – Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2026**

- There will be no studio closures during this term.

Term 1 has 9 weeks.

### **Term 2 – Monday 20<sup>th</sup> April – Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> June 2026**

- The studio will be closed Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> April (ANZAC Day)
- The studio will be closed Monday 4<sup>th</sup> May (Labour Day)

Term 2 has 10 weeks and those students with classes scheduled on the above closure dates will not be charged.

### **Term 3 – Monday 13<sup>th</sup> July – Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> September 2026**

- There will be no studio closures during this term.

Term 3 has 10 weeks.

### **Term 4 – Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> October – Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> November 2026**

- The studio will be closed Monday 5<sup>th</sup> October (Kings Birthday)
- The studio will be closed from Monday November due to classes being held at the Burdekin Theatre for our annual concert showcase. Normal class costs will still apply, as these rehearsals will have just been relocated to the theatre. All acro classes during this period will be cancelled and you will not be charged.

Term 4 has 8 weeks and those students with classes scheduled on the above closure dates will not be charged.

# OTHER INFORMATION

## **CLASSES**

- Classes are conducted on a “Closed Door” basis, where family and friends are asked to wait outside during lessons. We find that children struggle to focus with parents in the room. Please respect this policy.
- We ask that students arrive at least 5 minutes before their class and warm up in the foyer area. Please ensure your child is dressed in the correct clothing and footwear before entering their class.
- There will be three ‘display classes’ throughout the year to allow parents and family members to see what their child has been learning. However, permission for viewing classes will be given on special occasions such as grandparent visits etc. Please ask the teacher one week prior to the visit.

## **TUITION FEES AND ATTENDANCE**

- We charge a \$40 Registration Fee (non-refundable) to be paid upon enrolment, to ensure commitment by the student and a secured place in class/s. This also goes toward admin costs.
- Fees will be charged via our online portal, please ensure your email address is correct in our portal. Payment plans are available.
- Refunds will not be given for missed classes unless a mutual agreement is made.

## **EXAMINATIONS**

Exams are a valuable way to track a dancer’s progress while encouraging goal-setting, discipline, and technical development. Jazz and Tap exams are held during Weeks 7–10 of Term 2, with Ballet exams taking place in July/August.

Participation in exams is not compulsory and is offered to select students who demonstrate commitment and readiness. If you would like your child to be considered and have not heard from us by Display Week of Term 1, please feel free to reach out.

## **END OF YEAR CONCERT**

This is an exciting opportunity for all students to perform in front of their family, friends and the local community as well as showcasing all of their hard work throughout the year. The production is held on the last weekend in November. Even though we strongly encourage all students to participate, please remember participation in the concert is 100% your choice and is not compulsory. Each class your child attends will generally perform 1 dance, needing 1 costume. So, if your child attends 3 classes they will perform in 3 items and need 3 costumes. Costumes are approx. \$100-\$160 per costume. We try to keep the acro and hip hop costumes as low key as possible, so these are generally less expensive and are clothing items that can be used again in class. All performers will pay a concert participation fee, which covers extra incidentals as well as a commemorative T-Shirt.

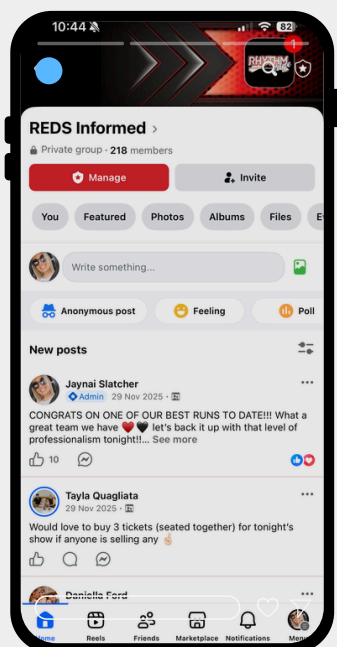

## END OF YEAR CONCERT

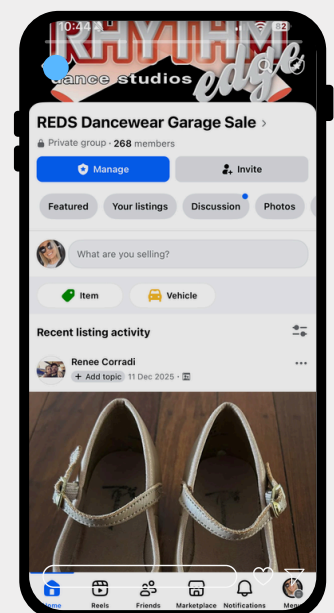
